Pre-Lesson Comprehension

Target Language: simple past tense (irregular verbs)

Focus: In this lesson, you will understand *irregular verbs* with the *simple past tense* to talk about finished actions and events.

Read and understand the target language below.

We use the **simple past tense** to talk about finished actions. The actions may be short or long. For example:

- I played tennis with my friends last weekend.
- My parents visited me last month. They stayed for two weeks.

In the above examples, the verbs added **-ed**. However, other verbs are **irregular** and much of the word changes.

- I ate at an expensive restaurant last Saturday.
- He came home late last night.

Unfortunately, you must memorize the form of the **irregular verb**. Here are more **irregular verbs**:

VERB		IRREGULAR	VERB		IRREGULAR
begin	\Rightarrow	began	know	>	knew
break	-	broke	make	-	made
drink	-	drank	see	-	saw
eat	\Rightarrow	ate	sell	-	sold
find	\Rightarrow	found	sit	-	sat
go	\Rightarrow	went	take	-	took
have	\Rightarrow	had	write	⊃	wrote

When the sentence is negative, use the following structure: **subject + didn't + base verb + object**.

- I didn't eat at an expensive restaurant last Saturday.
- He didn't come home late last night.

For questions, use the base verb again.

- **Q:** Did you eat at an expensive restaurant last Saturday?
- A: No, I didn't (eat at an expensive restaurant). I ate at a cheap restaurant.
- **Q:** When did you come home last night?
- A: I came home late last night.
